| Using camera inappropriately on ChromeBook | Lose Chromebook; App uninstalled |
| Too loud at partner reading | No Partner Reading for a couple days |
| Work not completed | Do in study hall or at home for homework. |
| Playing around in BR | Must use BR by his/herself at the end of the class BR break. Not allowed to go to BR except with group. |
| Too loud or disruptive in hall | Student must always walk next to teacher. |
| Student disruptive at desk | Student must sit next to teacher to complete work. |
| Student disruptive in whole group gathering | Student must sit right by the teacher. |
| Students are not using a Level 1 Whisper Voice | Give warning; If it continues, students are not allowed to talk at all. |
| Notes not turned in to parents; AB not signed after behavior issue | Student must call parents. |
| Cheat on study island group session | Lose Chromebook - have to hand-write answers |
| Lose Recess Time to Practice Skill | |
| Talking in hall | Come in at recess to practice walking quietly in the hall. |
| Running in hall | Come in at recess to practice walking in the hall. |
